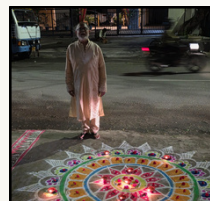

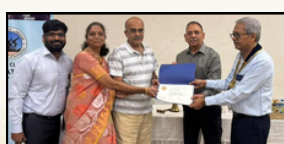
## Vijayadashami Celebrations at TV Nagar School and ASLC

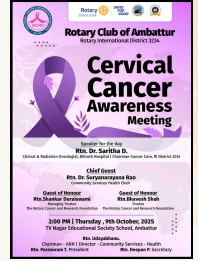
